

WV HIGHER EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST

Academic requirements are to be checked only once during the year. The grades to be reviewed are those at the end of the summer term prior to the award year. A student may not receive an award for a summer term. A student may not receive the state grant and Future Workforce Grant during the same payment period. Also, a student can only receive the grant for 8 semesters.
